Upon completion of the state approved program, candidates are qualified to apply for principal certification, and those possessing a valid New Jersey Instructional Certificate and three years of teaching experience may also apply for supervisor certification. The program also meets endorsement standards for school business administrator and school administrator certification.

- Statement of Objectives
- Copy of NJ Standard Teaching Certificate

### **Application Deadlines:**

Priority deadlines of August 1 for Fall  
Applications will be accepted after this date on a space available basis.

### **Location:**

All required courses are offered at the Communiversity location in Wall Township, NJ.

### **Tuition:**

\$541/credit, plus semester fees (2009-2010 academic year).

### **Transfer Credit:**

Students may transfer up to 6 credits.

### **Registration & Advisement:**

Upon acceptance, students will receive instructions about registration and advisement.  
Coursework begins in the Fall semester. The program is cohort based.
