Admission Requirements:

Students are required to present the following credentials when applying for admission to New Jersey City University (NJCU):

1. Completion of an NJCU graduate admissions application
2. A Bachelor's degree in Accounting or a Business related field is preferred
3. Official transcripts from each institution attended
4. Recent GMAT scores
5. Two letters of recommendation
6. Essay discussing your academic objective, including your reason for pursuing a graduate program. Indicate your career goals and special interests.
7. Resume

How to Apply:

Applications can be completed online at www.njcu.edu/business. Please indicate in your personal statement your interest in the Communiversity.

Application Deadlines:

Priority deadlines of August 1 for Fall, December 1 for Spring and May 1 for Summer admission. Late applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Part-Time:

This is a part-time program. Accounting undergraduates meeting the prerequisites of the program can fulfill the degree requirements within two years.

Location:

All required courses are offered online via WebCT, a learning management system. Students can access their NJCU online courses anywhere and anytime they have access to the internet and recommended web browser. Courses are also available on the NJCU campus.

Tuition:

The current fiscal year '10 in-state tuition rate, including fees, is \$536.15 per credit. Please note that tuition and fees are subject to change without notice by action of the Board of Trustees of New Jersey City University.

Transfer Credit:

A maximum of six graduate level credits (B or better) may be accepted as transfer credits.

Degree FAQ:

How many credits are required?

The program is a minimum of 33 credits. You may apply if you have an undergraduate degree in accounting or business. However, if your undergraduate degree is in a business field other than accounting you will be required to complete a minimum of 46 graduate credits. If your undergraduate degree is something other than business, there will be undergraduate business prerequisites required.
