Admission Requirements:

Completion of at least 30 transferable credits, including Calculus I and ENGL 121, with at least a 2.5 overall GPA.

How to Apply:

Applications may be completed online at www.njit.edu. Applicants should be sure to choose "Communiversity" as the campus location on the online application.

Application Deadlines:

Preferred deadline of October 15 for Spring. Applications will be accepted after these dates on a space available basis. Students may apply when they have met above admission requirements.

Part-Time/Full-Time:

Students may be part-time or full-time.

Location:

NJIT delivers the required major courses through various distance modalities.

Tuition:

\$400 plus fees per credit (08-09)

Transfer Credit:

A maximum of 62 credits may be accepted for transfer credit.

Degree FAQ:

How many credits are required?

134 credits required for the BS in Computer Science.

Can I attend courses at the home campus as well?

Yes. The upper level courses required for this degree can all be completed online. Students are welcome to attend at NJIT's main campus as well.

Once enrolled in this degree, can I take any additional Brookdale classes to count towards your degree?

Yes, if the courses are needed to complete your degree requirements. NJIT will not offer any course for which Brookdale offers an equivalent course.

What can I expect upon applying to NJIT?

Admission Decision Letter:

Approximately 2-3 weeks after submitting a complete application (a complete application includes an application, application fee, transcripts from all previously attended colleges, and for any International credential, a World Education Services-Foreign Academic Credentials Evaluation) you will receive an admissions decision letter. If you are accepted, your acceptance packet will include your acceptance letter, contact information for your advisor, and instructions how to review your transfer audit online. Shortly after this, you will receive an Orientation Invitation (to be held at NJIT's Newark Campus) where you can meet with your advisor in addition to registering for classes.

Transfer Evaluation:

Instructions detailing how to review your transfer audit online will be included in your acceptance packet.

Registration Information:

Entering students may register during orientation where advisors will be available. Students are required to with their academic advisor every semester prior to registering online.

Financial Aid:

Students must start the financial aid process by completing a FAFSA form at www.fafsa.ed.gov, selecting NJIT as their college choice.
