Admission Requirements:

Applicants must have successfully completed a four-year baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university with a minimum grade point average of 2.8 on a 4.0 scale.

Application Deadlines:

Priority deadlines of August 1 for Fall (non-matriculated), January 15th (non-matriculated) for Spring. Applications will be accepted after these dates on a space available basis.

Students may be part-time or full-time.
