

RISK ASSESSMENT

Student Conduct/Disciplinary Violation
Student Conduct Violation, i.e.
lateness, rudeness, swearing, or
distracting behavior
-Frequent interruptions, i.e. cell
phone, or electronic devices

Faculty should
address behavior
with student before
completing an
incident report.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN

1. Complete Incident Report
2. Submit report to Richard Pfeiffer or Robert Quinones.
3. Encourage student to make a Counseling appointment.

MODERATE RISK
Anxiety i.e.,
break-ups, failed tests/test
Anxiety, car problems, pressure from
parents
Crying/Changes in hygiene
Student reveals personal information
Mental health history

Note: Confidentiality can not
be broken unless the student is
a danger to self or others!

ACTION TO BE TAKEN

**Ask student's permission to
Notify**
-Counseling Office

HIGH RISK (CRISIS)
-Suicidal/homicidal ideation
-Physical violence
-Medical emergency
-Drug overdose
-Threatening behavior (verbal/physical)

ACTION TO BE TAKEN

Notify in the order below:
-Campus Police
-Counseling Office and/or College
Nurse

Note: HECs should use local municipal
Police Departments via 911 in the event of an
emergency!
