Dear Honors Student:

Our records indicate that you have taken at least one Honors course at Brookdale Community College in recent semesters. If you are working towards graduating with Honors from Brookdale, this letter contains important information for you.

Curricular changes to Honors at Brookdale will apply to students entering the program in the Fall of 2010. Because you began Honors studies prior to this date, **these changes will not apply to you**. If you wish to graduate with Honors, you need to complete the requirements of your present program which are:

- Three Honors sections of general education classes and one interdisciplinary Honors seminar,
- B or higher in your Honors courses, and,
- An overall G.P.A. of 3.5.

Please note that starting in the Fall of 2011, we will no longer offer interdisciplinary Honors seminars. Therefore, if you haven't already taken a seminar, you will need to complete this program requirement **no later than Spring 2011**. We will continue to offer seminars during Summer II of 2010, Fall semester of 2010, and Spring semester of 2011. Honors sections of general education classes will continue to be offered.

An information session about Honors offerings for the Fall of 2010 will be held **March 23, 11:30-12:30 in MAN 104**. I will be happy to answer your questions about changes to the Honors program at that time.
