How to get a Monmouth County Photo ID
(for Monmouth County residents only)

If you are under 21 years old

- Certified birth certificate issued by town with raised seal; if you were born in Jersey City or Secaucus you must get a new birth certificate.
- Social Security card
- If you are 18 – 20 years old, you must have something postmarked with your own name and Monmouth County address.
- If you are under 18, you must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian (bring guardianship papers) and the parent's driver's license will serve as proof of minor's residency.
- \$13.00 check, Visa or Mastercard only.
- You do not need a photo; it will be taken there.
- With proper documentation, this process will take less than two hours.
- Hours: 8:30 am until 4:00 pm Monday through Friday

If you are 21 years old or older

- Certified birth certificate issued by town with raised seal; if you were born in Jersey City or Secaucus you must get a new birth certificate.
- Social Security card
- Something postmarked with your own name and Monmouth County address.
- \$13.00 check, Visa or Mastercard only.
- You do not need a photo; it will be taken there.
- With proper documentation, this process will take less than two hours.
