

Brookdale downs Camden County

Joe Parella (Howell) scored a pair of goals and Moises Iniguez (Manasquan) had two assists to lead the Brookdale Community College men's soccer team to a 3-1 victory Tuesday over host Camden County College. After a scoreless first half, Parella and Iniguez teamed up to give Brookdale (8-1-2) a 1-0 lead at 53:00. Iniguez then assisted on a goal by Frank Clemente (Marlboro) to make it 2-0, and Parella added his second goal to give the Jersey Blues a 3-0 lead.
