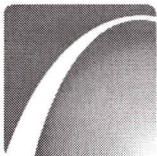


Summer accelerated alternate route program to **BECOME A SCHOOL LIBRARIAN**

Would you like to be a K-12 school librarian? Do you have a Bachelor's Degree but not a New Jersey teaching certificate? New Jersey City University's School Library Media Specialist Program is offering the "Summer Accelerated Alternate Route Program," which will give you the alternate route courses so that you can begin taking School Library courses with us in the Fall.



Classes meet on four Saturdays (May 22, June 5, June 19, and June 26) from 9:00 to 3:00 at the Communiversity. The face-to-face meetings are supplemented by online instruction. You will receive 9 graduate credits for the three courses — and the added benefit is that when you take all three courses, you will receive a 10% discount in the tuition.

The three graduate courses are:

- Educational Theory and Curriculum Design for the School Library Media Specialist (EDTC 647)
- Student Learning Development and Behavior Management for the School Library Media Specialist (EDTC 648)

■ Teaching Methodologies for the School Library Media Specialist (EDTC 649)
