

Photo exhibit, crafts, on tap this month at Monmouth Museum

The Monmouth Museum is hosting holiday programs and activities on Sunday afternoons from 2-3 p.m. during December. All programs are free with museum admission.

- “All Things Jersey,” an exhibit by Dorn’s Classic Images Photography Collection, is on view through Dec. 31. Travel back in time and New Jersey history with a special presentation of period photos from the Dorn’s collection. For more than 15 years, Kathy Dorn Severini has been the curator of nearly 10,000 vintage images of Monmouth County and New York City. Dorn’s photographs are on display in the museum’s hallway gallery, and prints are available for purchase either matted or framed.

- Dec. 11, “Scavenger Hunt for Captain Kidd’s Treasures” — follow in the footsteps of this legendary pirate and explore the museum on a scavenger hunt to discover hidden treasure.

- Dec. 18, “New Jersey Crafts” — learn how to make fun crafts with themes reflecting New Jersey history and culture.
