

Atlantic Cape men's basketball falls to Williamson

The Williamson Free School men's basketball team, of Media, Pa., beat visiting Atlantic Cape Community College 67-61 on Tuesday.

For the Buccaneers (12-9), Armin Cane (Pleasantville) had 18 points and five rebounds, and Muji McBride (Atlantic City) added 17 points and 13 rebounds. Also for the Buccaneers, Cesar Sandoval (Absegami) and Nate Brown (Atlantic City) had 10 points apiece, and Anthony Woodard (Atlantic City) added nine rebounds and seven blocks.

Atlantic Cape hosts Brookdale Community College at 7 p.m. Thursday at the Mays Landing gym.

Ocean County College women's basketball: Ocean County beat visiting Camden County College 71-36 on Tuesday in Toms River. Liz Lawler (Lacey Township) led the Vikings (12-2) with 22 points, 16 rebounds, three blocks and four steals. Teammate Amber Nafziger added 12 points and Amanda Fernandez had 10 points, five assists and three steals. For Camden County (4-13), Dominique King-Wimberly led with 14 points.

Ocean County College men's basketball: Camden County College beat the host Vikings 70-60. Tim McDaniels led Camden (16-3) with 21 points. For Ocean (12-6), Jamario Clayton and Lawrence Brodie scored 17 points apiece. Clayton also had five rebounds and three steals, and Brodie had nine rebounds. Ocean's Jeremy Watkins had 14 points, all in the second half.

The Ocean County men's and women's teams visit Cumberland County College on Thursday in Vineland. The women's game is at 5 p.m. and the men's at 7 p.m.

Atlantic Cape Community College archery: Sungwoo Shin, a current Atlantic Cape archer, won the men's recurve division at the Atlantic Cape Community College Alumni Archery Shoot on Saturday and Sunday in Mays Landing.

The event was for current and former ACCC archers, as well as current and former collegiate archers from other colleges.

Shin had a winning score of 541. Anthony Marino, another current ACCC archer, was second in men's recurve (527) and teammate Austin Hare was third (510). Robin Cruz, another current Atlantic Cape archer, won the men's compound division with a score of 536.

In the women's recurve division, current ACCC archer DanaJo Domenico finished fourth (496) and teammate Niki Meikle was sixth (486).
