

Brookdale offering chance to study around the world

Brookdale's International Center is offering a variety of short-term faculty-led study-abroad programs during the summer of 2012. Prospective travelers interested in Paris, Prague, Vienna or Rwanda study opportunities may journey abroad in May. An India program is offered during July.

Brookdale faculty will lead students outside the traditional classroom and show a firsthand look at history and culture. Students earn three to four hours of course credit or service learning credit for successful completion of the course and related requirements.

The programs are open to both students and community members aged 18 and older. Visiting students – those from colleges and universities other than

Brookdale - are also welcome. Early application is encouraged as some programs fill quickly.

The deadline for application to the May departure programs is January 31. The deadline for the July India program is March 1 with a special "early bird" discount for applications received by March 1. About study abroad through Brookdale:

Each year the International Education Center sponsors faculty-led study-abroad programs during the summer and winter terms. Programs last between seven and 21 days. Brookdale faculty lead the students outside

the traditional classroom and allow them a firsthand look at history and culture. Students generally earn three to four hours of course credit or service learning credit for successful completion of the course and its related components.

These programs are open to both students and community members aged 18 and older. Acceptance to any of the programs is determined by the order in which applications are received.
