Adjunct Faculty Positions

**II. Objective of Policy**

To provide authority to the President, subject to approval by the Board of Trustees, to appoint individuals to adjunct positions.

**III. Authority**

New Jersey Statutes - County Colleges, 18A:64A-12(f) and (g), General Powers of Boards

**IV. Policy Statement**

The President shall be authorized to appoint adjunct faculty, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees at its next regularly scheduled meeting. Adjunct faculty are individuals who do not hold academic rank, but may be qualified current Brookdale officers or employees. Normally, adjunct faculty shall not be assigned more than two course selections. Exceptions to assign a maximum of three course selections must be approved by the President.

All applicable provisions of the state administrative code and statutes shall govern the employment relationship with adjuncts with regard to pension contributions.
