IV. POLICY STATEMENT

The College recognizes its obligation to offer a variety of transfer programs which lead to the associate degree and provide the first two years of a four year college education.

Transfer programs will be offered in the arts and sciences as well as in a variety of specific career disciplines.

The College recognizes as its responsibility the offering of two-year career programs which prepare the graduate for employment.

Recognizing its role as a comprehensive community college, Brookdale will also offer career-oriented education programs of less than two years duration. Such programs prepare students for employment upon completion.

Programs will be developed on the basis of employment opportunities, availability of resources, suitability for college-level instruction, and transferability.
