I. Title of Regulation

Board of Athletics and Recreation

II. Objective of Regulation

To develop a comprehensive College-wide program of Athletics and Recreation which will meet the needs and interests of the College Community.

III. Authority

Bylaws of the Board of Trustees, Section 1.3034(m)

IV. Regulation Statement

A. Membership: The members of the Board of Athletics and Recreation shall be:

1. The Athletic Commissioner of the ASBCC.
2. One student from each Institute to be appointed by the Director of Student Life and Activities and the Institute Dean.
3. One faculty member from each Institute to be appointed by the Institute Dean.
4. The faculty member responsible for intercollegiate athletics.
5. The faculty member responsible for intramural/recreation and club athletics.
6. One non-academic staff member to be elected by the NASA membership.
7. The Dean of Human Affairs (ex-officio) with no vote.
8. The Director of Student Life and Activities (ex-officio) with no vote, who shall be Chairman of the Board.

B. Term of Office and Appointment:

1. Members will be appointed by the last week of the second long term to take office by the first week of the Spring Term.
2. All appointments will be for a term of one year from the time of appointment.

C. Meetings:

1. Regular or special meetings of the Board of Athletics and Recreation will be called by the Chairman or his representative.
2. A quorum must be present to conduct a meeting.
 - a. A quorum will be a majority of the official members of the Board (7 of 12).

D. Committees:

1. Standing committees will include the Intercollegiate Committee and Intramural/Recreation committee.
2. Memberships will be established by the Board of Athletics and Recreation.
3. Functional responsibilities, procedures and programs will be established by each Committee to be approved by the Board of Athletics and Recreation.
4. Special committees may be set up by the Board for special responsibilities as deemed necessary. Committee members will be appointed by the joint Board. These members may include members of the College community who are not members of the Board of Athletics and Recreation.

E. Functions:

1. The Board to coordinate and plan programs to fulfill the needs and desires of Brookdale Community College. The Office of Student Life and Activities will, with the advice of the Board of Athletics and Recreation, handle all negotiations for personnel, supplies and equipment and facilities necessary for the assurance of a successful program.
2. The Board to approve the annual budget request for athletics and recreation for presentation to the ASBCC and the President of Brookdale Community College.
 - a. Finances will be drawn from the ASBCC and the College, and the percentage shall be 25% of the student services fund or 50% of the total Recreation and Athletics budget, whichever is realized first, and the remainder to come from the College.
 - b. All monies from ticket sales must be deposited with the ASBCC treasurer.

- c. The Board will determine all ticket costs to all athletic events with special consideration to the Brookdale Community College community.
- 3. The Board to assume other responsibilities as stipulated in the ASBCC Constitution or as necessary.
