II. Objective of Regulation

To define interdisciplinary courses and provide guidelines for their implementation.

IV. Regulation Statement

- A. Interdisciplinary courses are developed and taught by two or more faculty members from different disciplines who join forces to design curricula that reflect a multiplicity of disciplines in an integrated manner.
- B. When planning interdisciplinary courses, faculty will secure approval of appropriate departments and divisions.
- C. Interdisciplinary courses are to be distinguished from those that may be multi-dimensional in various ways but which are taught by one instructor or by members of the same discipline.
- D. Interdisciplinary courses will be identified with either an IDS or HON code and assigned to departments by Vice President. Previously approved IDS courses will continue in force.
- E. In the catalog, IDS or HON courses will be listed in appropriate places, with the departmental courses and with other interdisciplinary courses as a group.
- F. The Vice President for Educational Services will determine the appropriate compensation and opportunity for interdisciplinary course development and instruction.
