HOW CAN I PREPARE FOR ACCUPLACER?

The Accuplacer assessments required by Brookdale Community College include Reading, Sentence Skills (writing), Computation, and Algebra. Here are a few ways you can brush up before you come in to take the assessment.

Go to www.brookdalecc.edu – Click on Testing Center (under Community Interest), then click on Pre-Registration testing for a variety of online sources to practice. They include:

- A good online practice for a variety of tests and exams is www.testprepreview.com. Click on Accuplacer on the menu to the left.
