DUAL ADMISSIONS PROGRAM

What does Dual Admissions mean?

- **Simultaneous admittance** into both Brookdale Community College and New Jersey City University.
- **Guaranteed entrance** into a New Jersey City University Bachelor’s degree program offered at Brookdale’s Higher Education Center in Wall Township (assuming you meet the admissions requirements) after earning an Associate degree at Brookdale.

What are the benefits?

- **Special advising** from New Jersey City University personnel while enrolled at Brookdale.
- **Invitation to attend** New Jersey City University events related to your major while you are enrolled at Brookdale.
- **Ability to earn both degrees**—an Associate degree and a Bachelor’s degree—while maximizing the transferability of credits.
- **Reserved spot** in the Bachelor’s degree program at New Jersey City University.
- **Option to follow** the New Jersey City University degree requirements in place at the time of Dual Admissions Program enrollment or the degree requirements in place at the time of entrance to New Jersey City University.
- **Waiver of New Jersey City University application fee.**
- **No fee** to have transcripts from Brookdale sent to New Jersey City University.

Who is eligible to participate?

- Any currently enrolled Brookdale student who is interested in the New Jersey City University programs offered at Brookdale’s Higher Education Center in Wall Township, who is not in the last term of the Associate degree.

Where can I take the New Jersey City University part of the Bachelor’s degree program?

- All New Jersey City University courses are offered at Brookdale’s Higher Education Center in Wall Township. Courses are also available on-line.

What Brookdale and New Jersey City University programs are participating in the Dual Admissions program?

How many credits are required?

- A minimum of 128 credits is required for a Bachelor's degree at New Jersey City University. Students who are pursuing a double-major (including all education majors) are likely to need to earn more than 128 credits to satisfy the requirements of both major programs.

How many credits can I transfer from Brookdale Community College to New Jersey City University?

- All credits applicable to the Dual Admissions degree plans will transfer. Students who are pursuing a double-major (including all education majors) may require more than two years of full-time course work beyond the Associate degree to complete the Bachelor's degree requirements for both majors.
