The following terms and conditions shall apply:

1. Students must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
2. Courses with a grade of C or better are transferable.
3. Berkeley College will accept transfer credits only, not course grades.
4. Students from Brookdale Community College will be eligible to transfer to Berkeley Interior Design Program only at its Bergen campus in New Jersey.
5. Associate Degree students from Brookdale Community College transferring to Berkeley College will receive full junior status.
6. Brookdale Community College students participating in this transfer program will follow regulations and guidelines in this agreement and in the undergraduate bulletins at both Brookdale Community College and Berkeley College.
7. Berkeley College is on the quarter hour system, while Brookdale Community College is on the "semester hour system". One credit hour for Berkeley is equivalent to approximately 12 hours of scheduled class time.
8. BCC students will follow the regular junior and senior year sequence that all students follow.

If any of the above terms and conditions are not met, Berkeley College shall determine appropriate transfer of credit and admission on an individual course basis. Berkeley College will provide opportunities for meetings with students on the Brookdale Community College campus to provide information and assistance in transferring to Berkeley College.
