Georgian Court University will accept all Brookdale courses listed as requirements on the Communitiversity Psychology/Elementary Education degree plan (typically 60 credits) plus Brookdale requirements that are not part of the degree plan [e.g., Oral Communications course]. Remaining required course work (typically 61 credits) must be completed through Georgian Court University. Georgian Court University will accept up to 75 credits from Brookdale Community College or other community colleges. Up to 15 additional credits will be accepted from 4-year institutions. At least 30 credits must be earned at Georgian Court University, including at least 21 credits in the Psychology major.

Georgian Court University prefers that students complete the general education program as outlined above. However, please note the following: Effective Fall 2007, Brookdale Community College students who have earned an A.A. or A.S. degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 and have completed the general education requirements established in the statewide agreement will be able to transfer those general education credits in full to satisfy a minimum of 45 (A.A.) or 30 (A.S.) credits of the Georgian Court University General Education Requirements. Only courses in which a grade of "C" or higher has been achieved are eligible for transfer. Courses transferred have Georgian Court University general education equivalents will be transferred as those equivalent courses. Other general education courses required by Brookdale Community College will be transferred as general education electives. If an equivalency is not transferred, all three of the following general education courses must be taken: **a designated Religious Studies course, the Shaping Lives: Women and Gender course, and a Philosophical Ethics or Theological Ethics course.**

Students who have not earned a total of 51 credits in the general education area after completing the three courses listed above must earn the remaining general education credits by choosing courses that satisfy general education categories for which the students did not transfer equivalent courses.
