

TLC Annual Report July 2010 – June 2011: Fast Facts

- Over **42%** of course sections utilized the ANGEL Learning Management System (LMS).
- Over **8,000** students per term are using the ANGEL LMS.
- **20%** average increase in enrollment for fully online courses over the Fall 2010, Spring 2011, and Summer 2 2011 terms.
- **336** first-time online students attended orientations led by the TLC.
- **35** faculty certified to teach fully online courses through completion of Online Teaching and Learning: Systems and Students, taught by Norah Kerr-McCurry. **223** faculty have now completed the course.
- **201** faculty members attended the six scheduled TLC Roundtables. Topics were: “Sage on the Stage”; “Student Success: student preparation; pedagogical techniques”; “Setting Expectations, Credibility and Self-Disclosure”; “Academic Integrity”; “Pre-test, test, and memory techniques”: and “Improving Student Success; Faculty Role: Teach or Get Students Through?”.
- **8** major course development and learning object projects were completed by Dan Greenwood: **PHTY 105, CHEM 101, JOUR 101, HIST 215, BIOL 105 Lab, MATH 025 and 136, ACAD 089.**
- **137** faculty members attended ANGEL workshops.
- **75** faculty and staff attended the TLC Open House. With the theme of “Reflections”, the event celebrated the accomplishments of the faculty in collaborative and innovative approaches to teaching and learning.
- **137** students have taken the Smarter Measure assessment. 86 of those self-identified as prospective students; 34 self-identified as current online students; and 17 self-identified as current face-to-face students.
- **Norah Kerr-McCurry**, Director, was elected as Vice-Chair of the New Jersey Community Colleges Distance Education Affinity Group. Norah was also selected as a Barringer Award recipient.
- **Dan Greenwood**, Instructional Designer, was recognized as one of the “**World’s Quiet Heroes**” through the Heroic Imagination project sponsored by the Brookdale Psychology Department
- Mike Quassaunee and Norah Kerr-McCurry presented a workshop titled “**Mobile Revolution: Is Your College Ready?**” at the Innovations Conference sponsored by the League for Innovation in the Community College. Norah also presented a workshop with Larry Hartzell on “**Faculty Leading Faculty: Faculty Fellow**”. Mike and Norah presented the workshop to members of the **ETS staff**, to promote and provide professional development.
- The Teaching & Learning Center participated in the Volunteer Adjunct Support and Training Sessions (**VAST**) presenting on use of the ANGEL LMS.
- The Teaching & Learning Center worked with OIT to bring ANGEL into a Single Sign On (SSO) environment.
