



Permission to Enroll in an Honors Class

You may seek to secure the professor's permission to enroll in their Honors Course, without being in the Honors Program. This is a good option if (a) you want to try an Honors course to see if you like the Honors experience, (b) you want the experience but because of your major or accumulated credits, applying to the full program is not preferable, or (c) you are interested in the subject.

In order to register for the Honors course, you **MUST** meet **ALL** of the following criteria:

- (1) Provide your high school or college transcript with a 3.5 GPA
- (2) Submit a letter of recommendation indicating your preparedness for the rigors of Honors
- (3) Secure approval from Professor Fencik (MAS 049d) or Professor Moschberger (MAN 117c)
