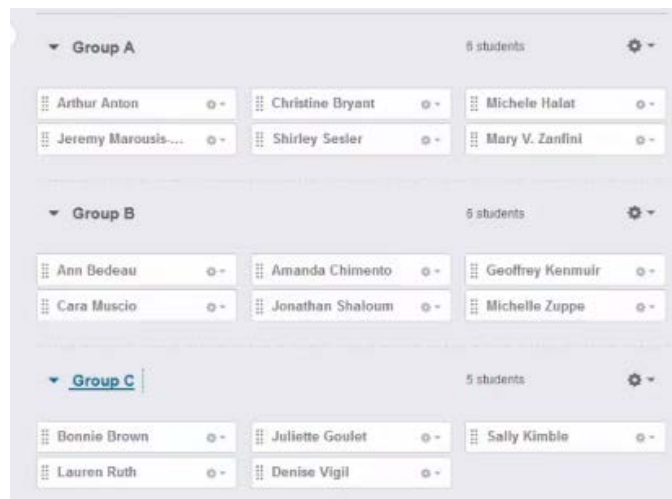


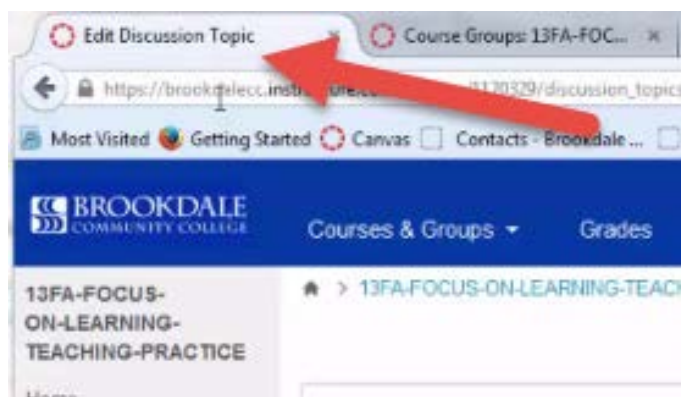
Canvas Tips for Faculty

Group Discussion

1. In the last video we created a group set and divided students into three equal groups group A group B and group C.



2. I want to set this as a group discussion. Students will only see other members of their group rather than the entire class. Click on **Edit Discussion Topic** at the top of the page.



3. I'll set this as a **Group Discussion**. Locate the section that says group discussion, and check the box.
