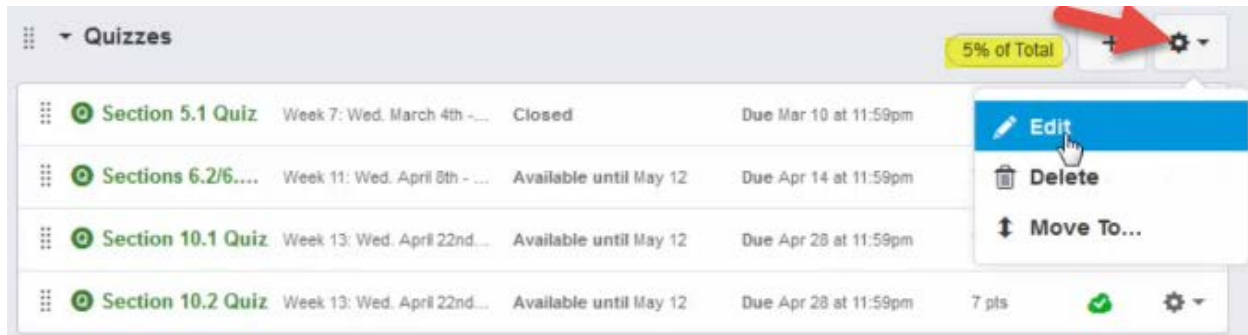




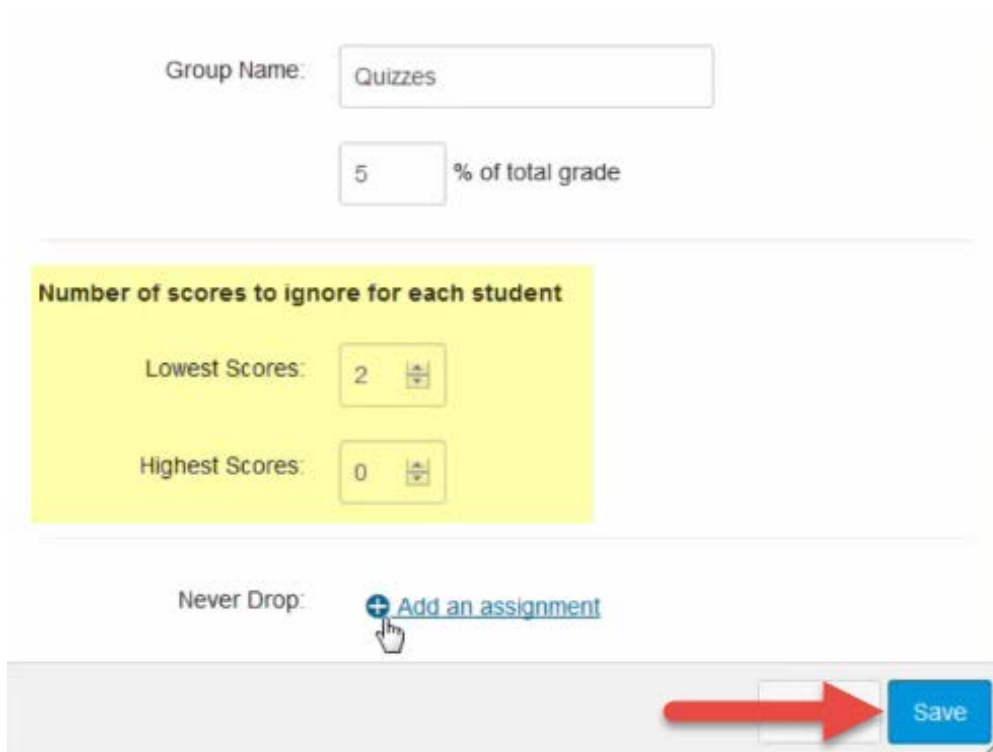
Canvas Tips for Faculty

Drop Lowest Scores

Grading rules enable you to add exceptions assignment groups such as *Drop the Lowest Grade*. Assignment groups can be *weighted* or *unweighted*. In this case, the assignment group called *Quizzes* is worth 5% of the total grade and each quiz has the same point value.

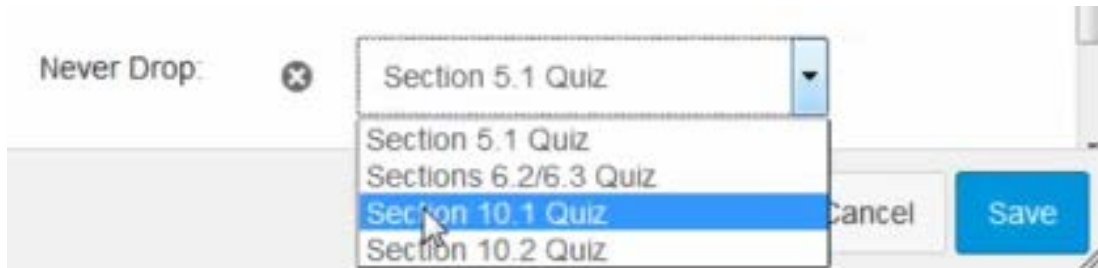


1. To create a grading rule, click on the **Gear** icon to the far right of the assignment group, and choose **Edit**.

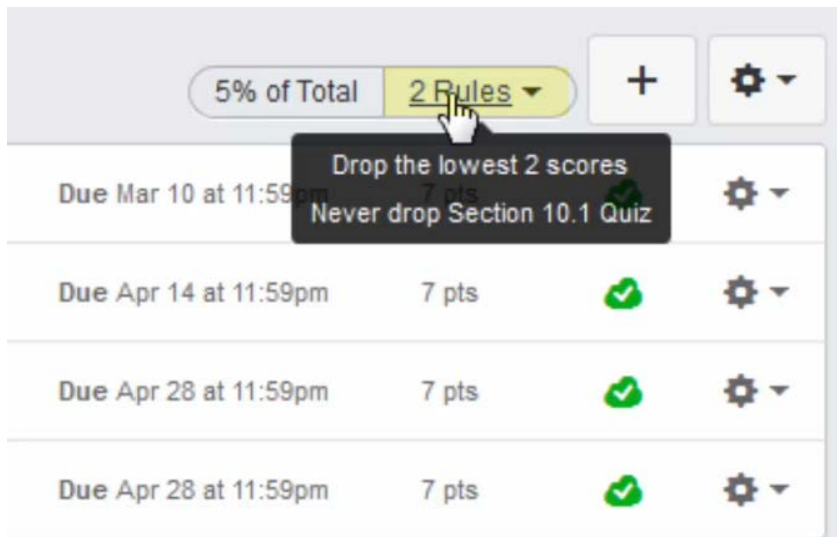
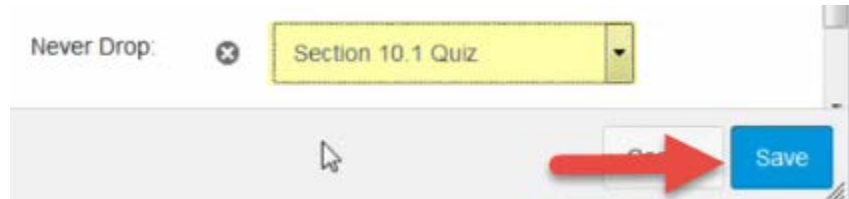


2. Under *Number of Scores to Ignore for Each Student*, enter the number of appropriate lowest or highest scores to ignore. You can also select a specific assignment to **Never Drop**.

3. Click on the blue **+ ADD AN ASSIGNMENT** and select the appropriate assignment from the dropdown to *never drop*.



4. When finished, click **Save** in the right corner.



5. Notice to the right of the *assignment group* is **2 Rules**. Place the cursor over the 2 rules link displays the *Grading Rules*. Canvas will always drop the score with the lowest percentage, regardless of the effect on the final grade.
