DAY 2 • ATHENS • JUNE 10

Upon arrival at the airport, greet your tour director and coach for panoramic and walking tour. Highlights include Syntagma Square where you'll view the parliamentary building and witness the changing of the guards at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier; The University, the Panatheneic Stadium, Hadrian's Arch and a visit to Temple of Olympia Zeus. Tour will end at hotel for check-in. Dinner at your leisure.

DAY 3 • ATHENS • JUNE 11

Continental Buffet Breakfast at the hotel

This morning, join your tour director for a visit to the Acropolis, the holy rock, and the memorials there – The Propylee, Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and the Parthenon. Afterwards, visit the new Acropolis Museum, which was built to showcase the Parthenon sculptures. This afternoon, continue your guided tour of ancient Greece with visits to the ancient Agora and the Keramikos site. Dinner at your leisure.

DAY 4 • DELPHI • JUNE 12

Continental Buffet Breakfast at the hotel

This morning, greet your tour director and coach for a full-day trip to Delphi, a UNESCO World Heritage site and the center of Ancient Greece. You'll enjoy a guided tour of the Delphi Archaeological site and a visit to the Delphi Archaeological Museum. Stop for lunch (not included) before returning to Athens. Dinner at your leisure.

DAY 5 • ATHENS • JUNE 13

Continental Buffet Breakfast at the hotel

This morning, join your tour director for a visit to the National Archaeological Museum. This afternoon, spend some time exploring the Plaka neighborhood with your tour director. You'll see the Lysikrates Monument, the Roman Agora and Tower of the Winds as well as Hadrian's Library. Afterwards, enjoy some free time in the local Monastiraki market. Dinner at your leisure.

DAY 6 • ATHENS • JUNE 14

Enjoy a full free day at leisure to continue exploring Athens. Your tour director will be available with suggestions. Dinner at your leisure.

DAY 7 • ATHENS • JUNE 15
