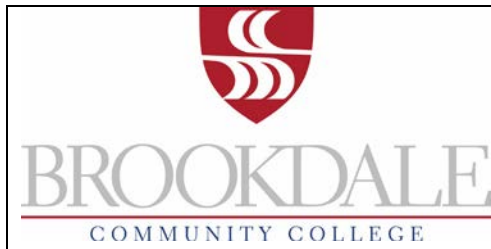

Mon June 1 Day 1	Departing from Newark on United Airlines Fly into Albuquerque – travel to Sante Fe, NM
Tues June 2 Day 2	Sante Fe - Visit health clinic near Ship Rock / Indian Hospital of Sante Fe / Tesuque or Pojoaque Reservation (outside Sante Fe) / Plaza / Museums / Church
Wed June 3 Day 3	Travel to Gallup, NM - Acoma Pueblo
Thurs June 4 Day 4	Visit Tsaile Health Center then onto Mesa Verde National Park near Cortez, CO (cliff dwellings)
Fri. June 5 Day 5	Visit Monument Valley / Tec Nos Pas Medical Center or Keyanta Health Center / through Navajo reservation to Tuba City, AZ
Sat June 6 Day 6	Tuba City to Fredonia, AZ (overnight in Kanab, UT)
Sun June 7 Day 7	Fredonia to South Rim Grand Canyon Village
