### **MINUTES**

### **BOARD OF SCHOOL ESTIMATE**

February 27, 2020

Hall of Records Freehold, New Jersey

- 1. The meeting of the Board of School Estimate was called to order by Mr. Thomas A. Arnone, Director, The Board of Chosen Freeholders, at 12 P.M., followed by the flag salute.
- 2. Ms. Gruskos called the roll:

Absent: Mr. Pat Impreveduto, Board of Chosen Freeholders

- 3. Opening compliance statement was read by Ms. Masnick, Clerk of the Board, Board of Chosen Freeholders. Ms. Masnick stated that this meeting is being held in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 231 of the Public Law of 1975, known as the Open Publics Meeting Act. Notice of this meeting was posted in the Hall of Records and the County newspaper.
- 4. A motion to approve the minutes of our previous Board of School Estimate Meeting held on February 26, 2019 was made by Freeholder Burry and seconded by Chair Abby-White. The motion was approved with one abstention (Mr. Henry Cram)
- 5. Dr. Stout presented a resolution approving the Operating and Capital Budget for 2020/2021 adopted by the Board of Trustees on February 18, 2020 (*Attachment A*). He presented an affidavit of publication indicating that the Board of School Estimate meeting was advertised according to law in the *Asbury Park Press.* (*Attachment B*)
- 6. Freeholder Director Arnone opened the floor for public comment, limiting comment to discussion to the operating and capital budgets. A motion to open the public hearing was made by Freeholder Burry and seconded by Chair Abby-White. The motion was unanimously approved.

The following made comment:

Dr. Stout thanked the Freeholders for their financial support. He provided information on the College's ability to add \$7 million dollars to our reserves in the past 2 years. He pointed out that the presented

operating and capital budgets, include a decrease of \$1 million in operating expenses, a \$3 tuition increase, and that the College will continue to cut expenses, and act conservatively with the use of our resources. He further stated that the College was able to refinance our debt, which provided further savings, and he thanked the Board of Chosen Freeholders for their guidance. He brought to their attention that the capital budget, over the course of the last years, has been used to beautify the campus, and he expressed gratitude for the support of the County. Dr. Stout shared the good news, that the upcoming Chapter 12 allocations are increased to \$5.8 million, assuming support of the County. This was an almost 2 million increase from the anticipated allocation. Dr. Stout explained that we are projecting a 5.7% decline in enrollment for the next fall semester. Chair Abby-White responded about the desire of the College to provide programs that will serve the community and attract non-traditional students.

In response to questions about free community college, Dr. Stout explained how students receive funding for the Community College Opportunity Grant (CCOG) as a last dollar scholarship, if their family's adjusted gross income is less than \$65,000. He further described that the College received a \$250,000 grant which goes directly to the College, for the implementation costs of CCOG.

The Freeholders discussed transportation needs of our students and Dr. Stout provided information on our attempts to continue improve accessibility.

- 7. No other requests to be heard were made, and it was moved by Freeholder Burry and seconded by Chair Abby-White that the public hearing on the fiscal year 2020/2021 Operating and Capital Budgets for Brookdale Community College be closed. The motion was unanimously approved.
- 8. A motion was made by Chair Abby-White and seconded by Freeholder Director Arnone to approve by resolution (*Attachment C*) the Operating and Chapter12 money necessary to support Brookdale Community College for the 2020/2021 fiscal year. Signed Certificates (*Attachment D*) Motion passed by the following vote:

### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Brookdale Community College is seeking approval for the use of Chapter 12 P.L. 1971, in the amount not to exceed \$5,831,000 for the projects associated with site and infrastructure renovations, improvements to utilities, restrooms, roofing, drainage, flooring and rehabilitation projects to classrooms, HVAC, plumbing, and electrical efficiency and restorations, and life safety initiatives at all College locations and as identified as top priorities in the 2012 Board approved Facilities Master Plan and subsequent updates; and
