Support is defined as cash support, payment by the parent of educational costs, health insurance benefits, other financial obligations you have incurred, and/or non cash support such as room and board.

- 1. You must submit a dated and signed letter from a parent specifically stating that the parent(s)
 - Has stopped providing financial support to you (including the date when the financial support • stopped)
 - Will not provide financial support in the future •
 - Refuses to complete the parental section of a FAFSA
- 2. If you are unable to provide a letter from you parent(s) you must obtain documentation from a third party (e.g., teacher, counselor, clergy) describing your relationship with your parents and their refusal to provide parental support and completion of the FAFSA.
