

# Cheryl Cummings Memorial Scholarship

Cheryl Cummings retired from Brookdale Community College in 2015 having served as the Executive Director of the Brookdale Network. She then attended and completed the Pastry Arts Credit Certificate Program at Brookdale's Culinary Center in Asbury Park. She started her own pastry chef business called Cher Bread in Little Silver. She passed away in fall 2015 after a brief illness. Friends and colleagues honored Cheryl's memory by funding a memorial scholarship through the Brookdale Community College Foundation.

This \$250 scholarship for fall 2017 will be awarded to a student currently enrolled in the Pastry Arts Credit Certificate program who has financial need, has completed a minimum of 12 credits, has a GPA of 3.0 or better, and is a Monmouth County resident. The scholarship will be credited to the student's account. Applicants should submit a brief essay stating why you want to pursue a career in pastry arts and what this scholarship would mean to you.
