ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The International Education Center awards The Elaine Baran Scholarship to students participating in select study abroad programs. The scholarship was established to honor the life and achievements of Elaine Baran, a long-time member of the Brookdale family who was dedicated to both the Brookdale and global community. Her passion and motivation for sharing the international experience were key in the development of BCC's international programs.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be enrolled as a Brookdale Community College student participating in a College Consortium for International Studies (CCIS), BCC Faculty-Led Program, or, an approved non-CCIS program, which awards academic or service-learning credit upon completion. Preference may be given to applicants who have completed fifteen (15) credits at the time of application. Previous recipients of the scholarship will not be considered; however, previous applicants are eligible to reapply.

INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants must first apply for their study abroad program (i.e. application, references, personal statement, and transcript) **before or at the same time** as applying for the Elaine Baran Scholarship.

To be considered for the Elaine Baran Scholarship, a complete application packet must include:

- a completed scholarship application and agreement form
- a typed personal essay (two pages minimum, double-spaced) addressing the following:
 - why you should be considered for this scholarship
 - o your interest in the program and host country
 - o academic merit
 - your financial need
 - how you will share your study abroad experience with the BCC community
- an unofficial transcript, which you can download from Student Planning (include transcripts from previous colleges or universities if applicable)
- an academic letter of recommendation (additional letters are acceptable)

For consideration, students must submit a complete scholarship <u>and</u> program application along with all supporting materials and documents by the following dates:

October 15
