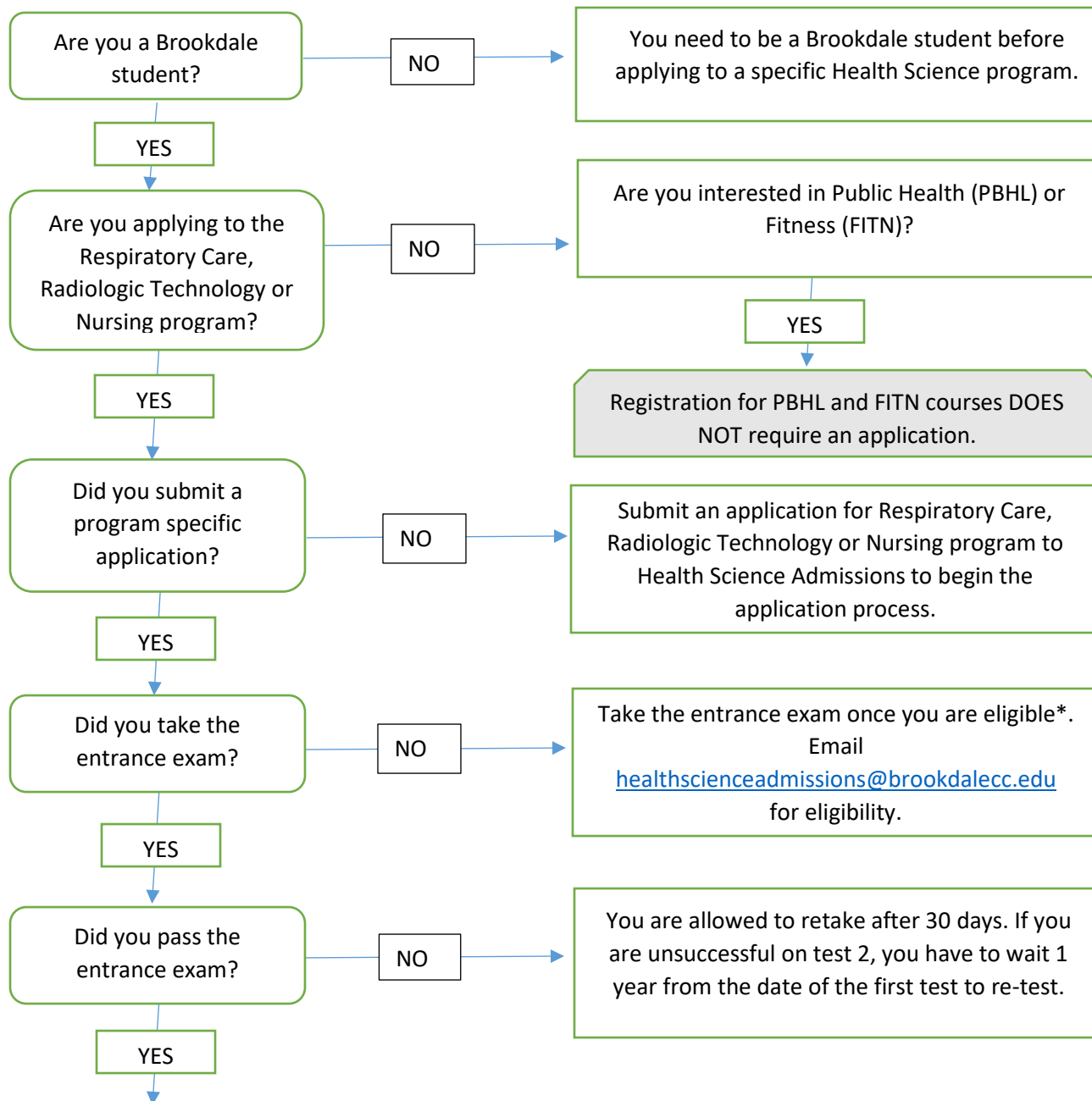


How Do I Apply to A Health Science Program?



You will be invited to a Spring or Fall Information Session from Health Science Admissions. Once you attend an Information Session, your application is complete, and you will be put on a waiting list. Your place on the wait list is based first on date of application to the program and then on date of attendance at an Information Session.

NOTES

- Health Science Admission is a multi-part process: 1. Submit an application form 2. Pass the entrance exam 3. Attend an information session
- *Foundational study classes must be completed before taking the entrance exam AND High School Biology and Chemistry (or equivalents) must be completed before taking the entrance exam
- Criminal history clearance, negative drug screen and immunizations are required prior to entering the programs
- Nursing requires completion of a CNA/CHHA/PCA/PCT course (or equivalent work experience) prior to entrance to the program
