APPLICATION

Please note: You must apply for admission to Brookdale Community College before submitting this application. If your application is incomplete, it will not be considered.

A complete application packet will include:

☐ Honors Program application (see back)
☐ High school and/or college transcripts indicating at least a 3.5 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) or a 3.94 (on a 4.5 scale)
☐ Minimum SAT and/or ACT scores to waive the placement test (visit brookdalecc.edu/testing-services/ placement-testing for the current scoring range)
☐ A letter of recommendation from guidance counselor, teacher/professor or someone who can address yo preparedness for a rigorous program of study
☐ Required essay (see below)
☐ Resumé and/or list of achievements including awards, scholarships, and membership in clubs and other organizations. The admissions committee may also request an interview.

Required essay: Write an essay of 500-800 words on ONE of the following topics:

- 1) What is the value and importance of community service in our society and tell us what it means to you.
- 2) In your opinion, what is the greatest challenge your generation will face? What ideas do you have for dealing with this issue?
- 3) Discuss some issue of local, national, or international concern and its importance to you.
