



International Student **Certification of Financial Support** Instructions

All international applicants requesting an I-20 form (Certificate of Eligibility for F-1 status) are required to demonstrate financial ability to cover their educational and living expenses while at Brookdale Community College.

The estimated cost of attendance for the 2026-2027 academic year (based on 12 credit hours/semester) is as follows:

Tuition & fees	8,586
Living Expenses	21,000
Books & Supplies	<u>2,000</u>
	\$ 31,586

For each dependent add \$5,680

(Tuition & fees are subject to increase without notice.)

Required Financial Documentation

Applicants must demonstrate financial support equal to or greater than the estimated cost of attendance by providing the following:

1. **Certification of Financial Support** – Must be completed and signed by the sponsor to confirm financial commitment.
2. **Supporting Financial Documentation** – A bank statement or official financial document, issued within the last three months, verifying that the sponsor has sufficient funds available.

Note:

- Indicate all sources of funds and available amounts on the **Certification of Financial Support** form.
- Documents issued in the name of another college or university **will not be accepted**.
- Incomplete or missing documentation will delay or prevent the issuance of the I-20 Form.

Sources of Funds	Required Documentation
Personal Savings	Official bank statement
Family/Relative Personal Sponsor(s)	Official bank statement from sponsor(s). Sponsor(s) must sign the Declaration of Financial Support on page 2
Scholarship	Official scholarship award letter from the institution/organization awarding the scholarship. The award letter must contain the name of the applicant, the amount of money available for each year of study, the duration of the award, and the name of Brookdale Community College as the institution to which the award is applicable.
Loan	Official letter from the lending institution indicating approval of the loan and the amount approved.
Government/Employer/Other Organization	Official letter indicating amount of support and containing the name of the applicant, the amount of money available for each year of study, the duration of the award, and the name of Brookdale Community College as the institution to which the award is applicable.
