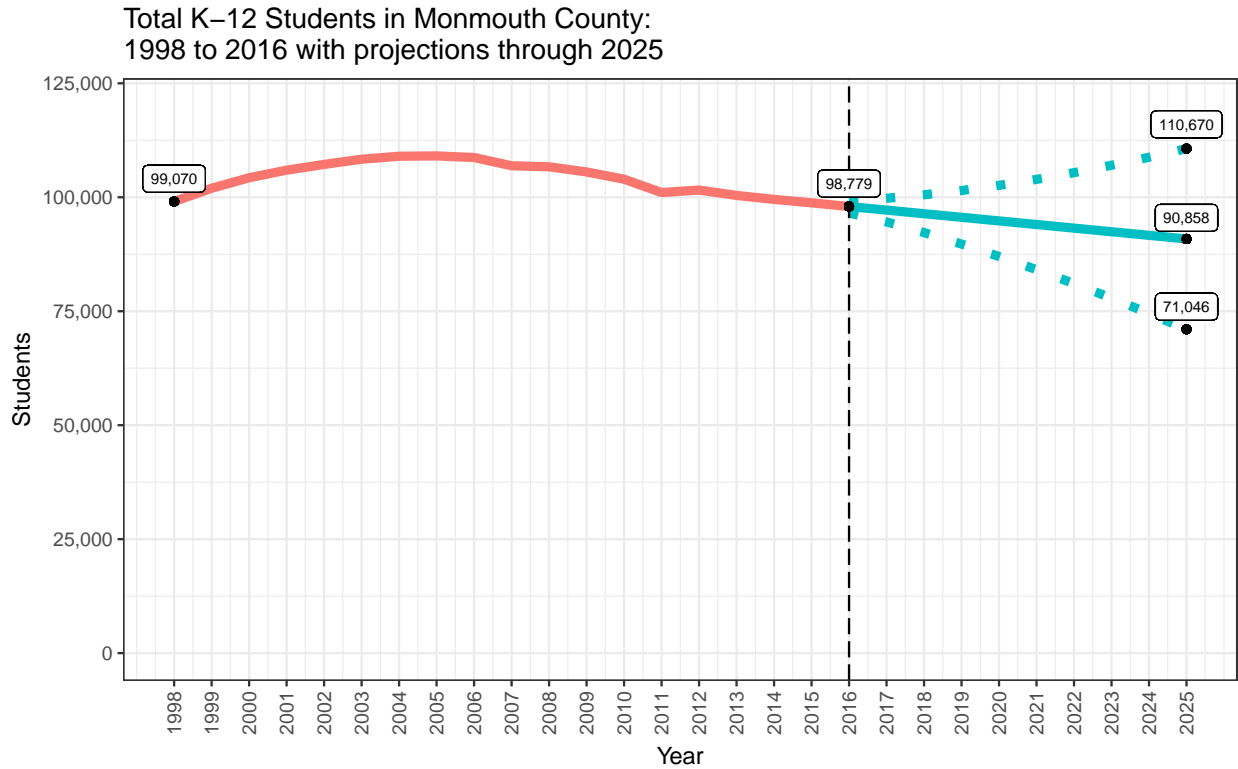


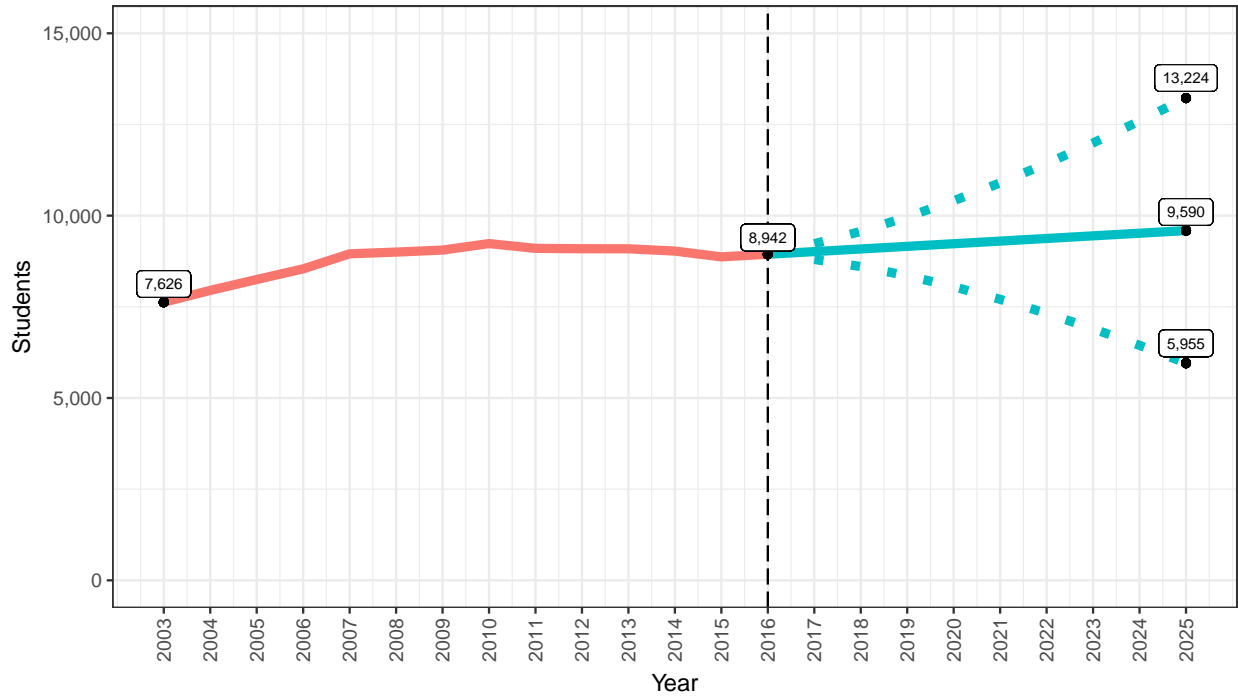
Hello Brookdalian,

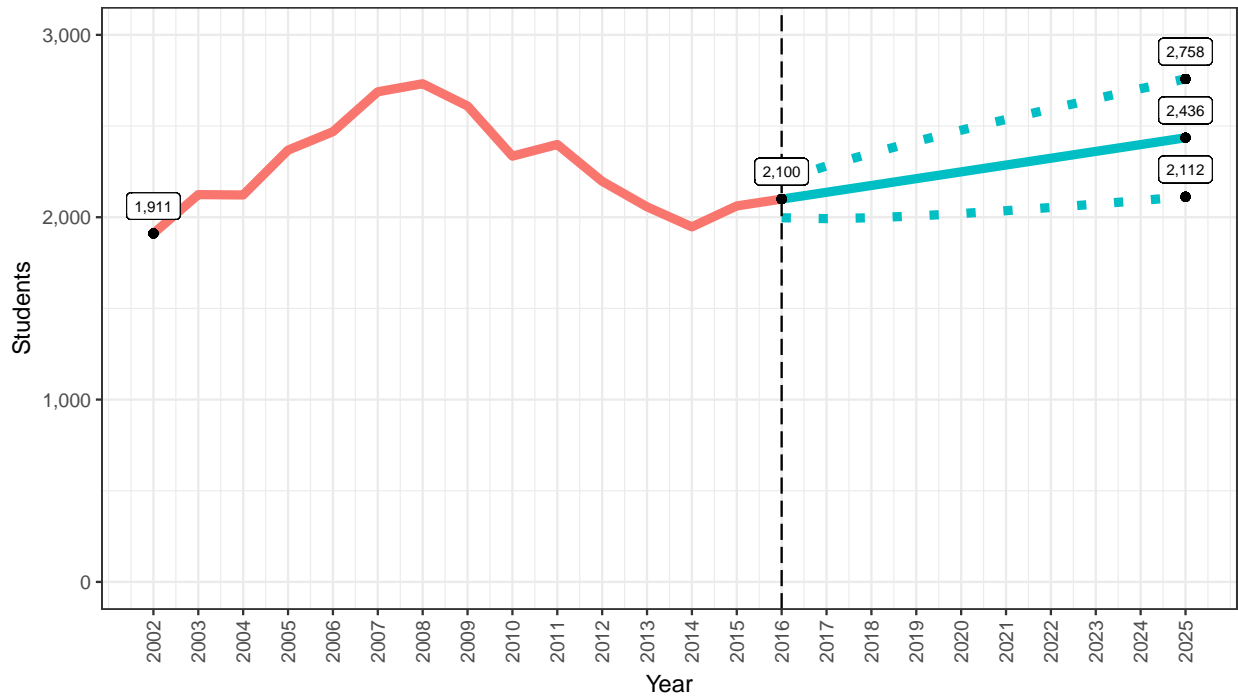
An Auto-Regressive Integrated Moving Average model with an 80 % confidence level was used for the projections.

1998 to 2016 with projections through 2025



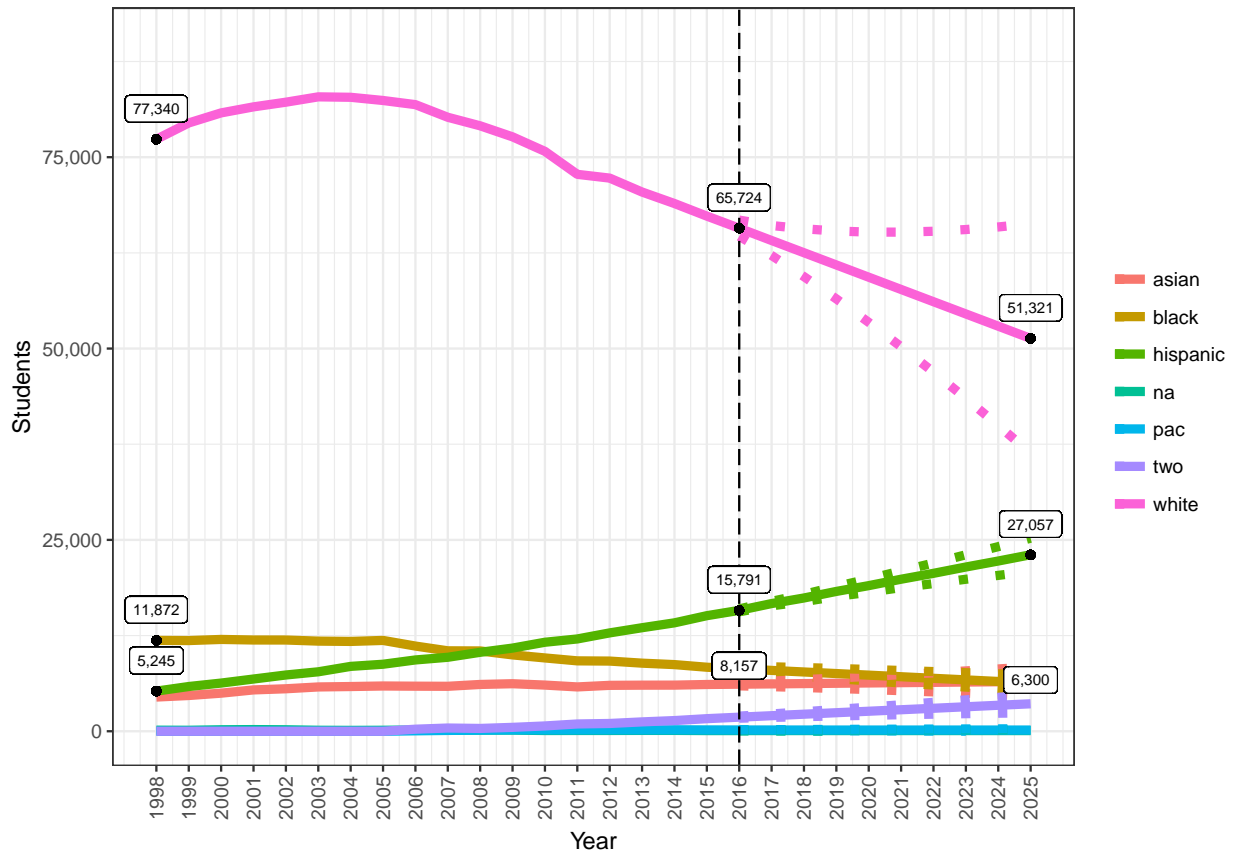
There has been a slight upward trend despite declines in overall K-12 enrollments.

1998 to 2016 with projections through 2025



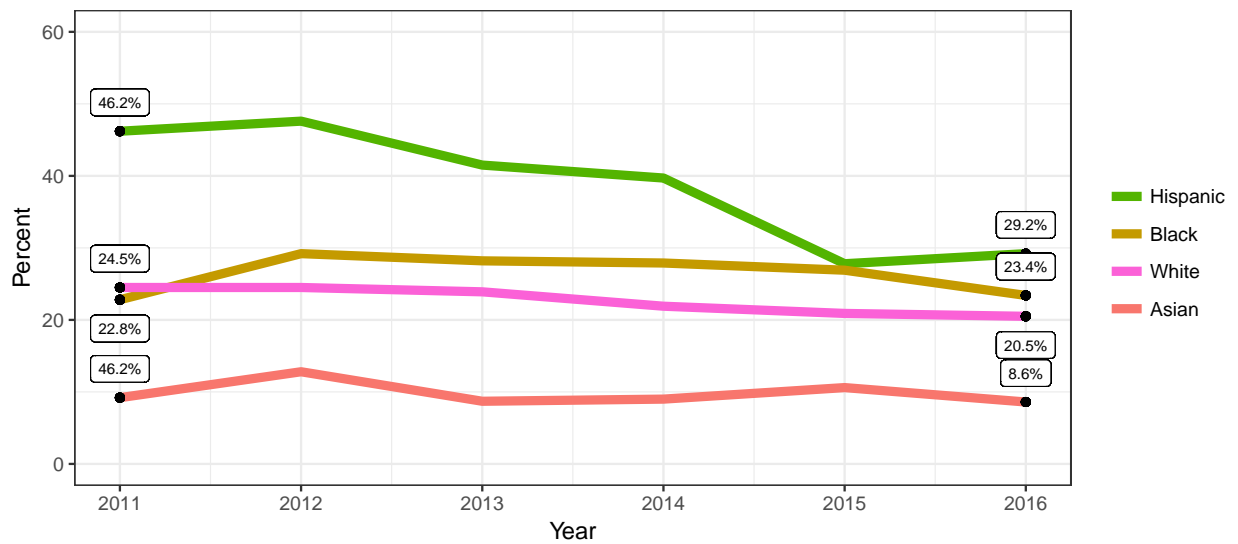
Projections are based on the 2016 yield of 26.6%.

1998 to 2016 with projections through 2025



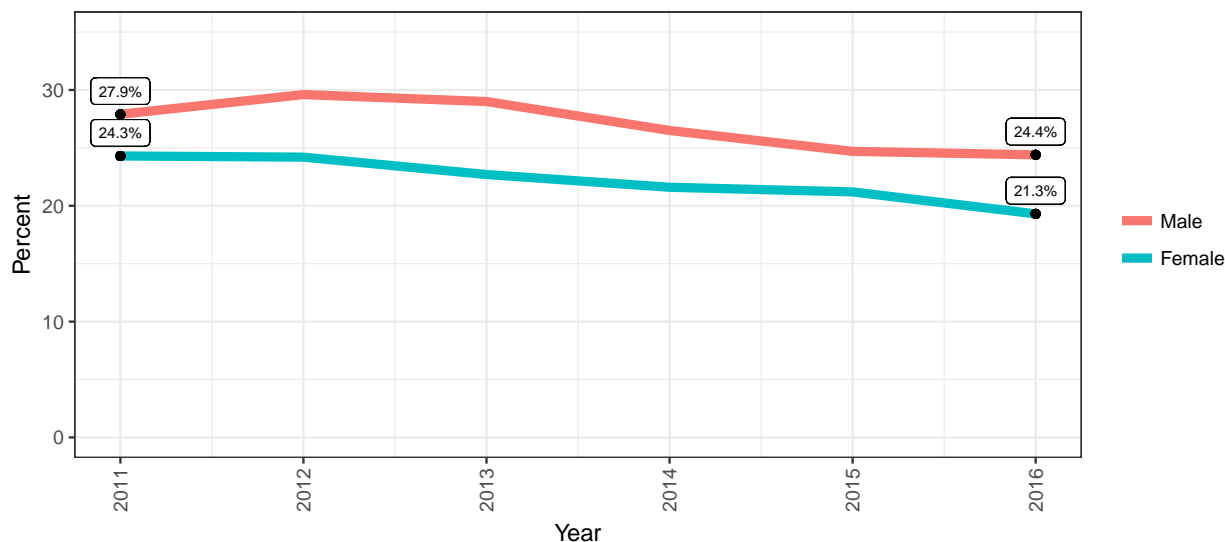

- . Enrollment by Institute, Course and Course Prefix: Fall 2012 - Fall 2016
- . Fall 2015 - Fall 2016 Retention by Program
- . Fall 2016 Average Age by Academic Program

[Foundational Studies Annual Profiles](#). The Foundational Studies Annual Profiles have been updated to include placement data for the Fall 2015 cohort, student success in Foundational Studies Courses through Spring 2016, graduation and transfer rates for the Fall 2012 cohort, and Foundational Studies status of the Class of 2016. Other recent Foundational Studies research includes average Accuplacer Scores for Fall 2005-2015; graphs depicting the percentages of new, evaluated students requiring Foundational Studies, and the number and percentage of students who enroll in college-level Math within two years of enrolling in MATH-011 or MATH-015. Results are reported separately by gender and ethnicity.

[Graduating Student Survey 2015/2016](#). The Graduating Student Survey is an attempt to collect the opinions of students just before they graduate.

Upcoming

The Ruffalo Noel Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory (SSI) will be administered this Spring. Brookdale first administered the SSI in November of 1996 in preparation for our 1998 Self Study and we have been

administering it regularly (every other Fall with a few exceptions) ever since. The Student Satisfaction Inventory measures student satisfaction and priorities and highlights areas where student expectations are not being met.
