



Good morning colleagues!

Greetings from Brookdale’s Planning and Institutional Effectiveness (PIE) department. Today we bring you the first of what will be our monthly update. These emails will include a few “Fast Graphics” meant to quickly convey information regarding the college as well as the region, and a brief overview of some of PIE’s activities (recent reports, and upcoming activities).

**Fast Graphics:**



(This chart shows the declining enrollment in Monmouth County Grade schools between classes that started in 1999 and 2014. Note that the scale starts at 6500 and not 0, thus showing a range of about 2,000)

## What we are up to:

- PIE's website has recently seen a major overhaul: The [new website](#) is up at and includes a reworked [Brookdale Community College Administrative Information System \(BCCAIS\)](#) which is where PIE houses all of our reports and data, which is accessible to ALL Brookdale faculty and staff (the old website will be removed, so update your bookmarks accordingly!). To login and access the BCCAIS files you now only need to use your Brookdale NetID (the same login you would use for canvas, email, etc.). These files are also accessible on [PIE's SharePoint site](#).
- Interested in helping us go green? In mid-to-late April, PIE will be piloting a new digital Student Opinion Report (SOR) tool which we hope to roll out to the entire college in the fall of 2016. - Brookdale's Biennial [Graduate Follow Up Report \(GFU\)](#) for the class of 2014 is now accessible (use your NetID to login and download it). The GFU provides data regarding the activities and opinions of Brookdale's graduates, including goal-attainment, transfer experiences, current employment, and overall opinion of experiences at Brookdale.
- [The Community College Survey of Student Engagement \(CCSSE\)](#) is being administered for the third time at Brookdale from April 1<sup>st</sup> to the 21<sup>st</sup>. CCSSE asks questions that assess institutional practices and student behaviors that are correlated highly with student learning and student engagement. The CCSSE results can be used as a benchmarking instrument, a diagnostic tool (e.g., identifying areas in which the college can enhance students' education experiences) and a monitoring device (documenting and improving institutional effectiveness over time). PIE greatly appreciates the Institute Administrators and their assistants help in the administration of the survey as well as the faculty and students in the (randomly selected) sections who are participating in the survey. The results from CCSSE will be available in the late summer/early fall.
