

SOR SURVEY ADMINISTRATION PROCEDURES

Spring 2020

1. If you are teaching your lecture via Zoom or other interactive mode, you can “proctor” your own SORs. Or you can select other options that are convenient for you (1) Send the student an email with the survey link in it. (2) Put the survey URL in Canvas and let students know when you would like them to complete the survey.

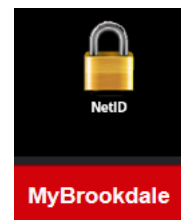
If students do not know their MyBrookdale NetID User Name or Password:

They can **look them up** by going to the Brookdale Homepage, clicking on “My Brookdale” (top right), and then NetID.

Students can **Change/Reset their password** here as well.

Students will enter their username, last name and either their social security number or 7-digit Brookdale ID number.

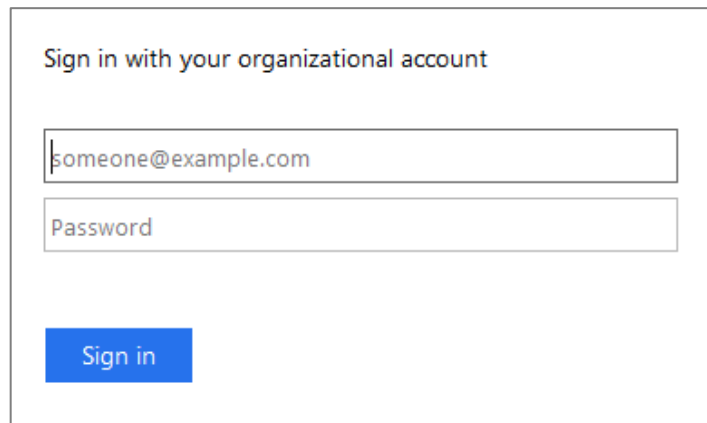


SOR Survey Administration Script

1. Write the following URL in an email, on a white board in Zoom or in a Canvas assignment (or any other way you would like to administer the survey this Spring as long as it is done electronically)

2. Tell students that their **User name** is their **complete Brookdale email address** (username followed by **@my.brookdalecc.edu**).
3. Their **Password** is their **NetID password** (this is the same password they use for their Student Email, WebAdvisor, and Canvas).
