**Brookdale Community College Footnotes:**

- (1) - One course is required from the Cultural & Global Awareness area. Students may meet the requirement while simultaneously fulfilling the General Education requirement for another knowledge area.
  - (2) - A minimum of 12 credits are required from the Mathematics, Sciences or Technology Competency
- A grade of "C" or higher is required in a Career Studies course.
- The Transfer Advising Guide is a recommended plan of study. Additional courses are transferrable as outlined on NJ Transfer for this major with the approval of a Rider University Advisor.

**Rider University Footnotes:**

For transfer the Brookdale student must have a "C" or higher in all courses for transfer credit

A – Suggested Brookdale courses include ENG-235, World Literature I; ENG-236, World Literature II; PHIL-225, Comparative Religions; HIST-225, History of Modern Asia; HIST-217, Modern Latin American History; HIST-145, African American History.

U - Students have a number of options to satisfy this requirement; courses will be evaluated on an individual basis.
