152 as prerequisites to MATH-153 or students may be placed directly in to MATH-171, Calculus and might need to make up those credits toward their A.S. degree.

Rider University Footnotes:

Students must earn a grade of "C" or better in BIO-115, BIO-116 and BIO-117 to meet their major requirements and before enrolling in upper-level courses for which these courses are prerequisites.
