1 - Brookdale students will still need to satisfy all the remaining areas of their Nursing Program curriculum and may end up graduating with more than 120 credits.

This degree may take longer than two and a half years to complete. BIOL-111 may be taken either before admission to the Nursing program or concurrently with NURS -160.

BIOL-111 must be completed before progression into NURS-161. The other general education courses may be taken before starting clinical courses or with the nursing courses.

For transfer credit Brookdale students must have a grade of "C" or higher in all courses listed in the Transfer Advising Guide
