- Article I. The name of the organization should be Brookdale Pre-Med Club
- the medical practices and how science, technology, and the surrounding environment affect living organisms, especially human beings, through a variety of activities, experiences and discussions.
- rticle III. Membership in this organization shall only be available to students of Brookdale Community College regardless of race, color, sex, or political, ethnic or religious affiliation. No student shall be excluded from participation in, or be denied the benefits of the organization on the basis of race, color, sex, or political, ethnic or religious affiliation. This organization shall not limit any member in the enjoyment of any right, privilege, advantage or opportunity.

ticle IV. The Executive Committee

Section 1: The Executive Committee shall be made up of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and an Activities Director.

Section 2: The Executive Committee shall be determined by election of the active membership at least once a year, unless otherwise decided. Nominations should be made at the meeting prior to the election, with notification of those nominations being sent to all members prior to the election meeting. Nomination may be re-opened by majority vote.

Section 3: The President shall preside over the meetings, acts as a spokesman for the organization, calls meetings, and acts as the overall official for the organization, in addition to other requirements which the organization might have. The Vice-President usually heads special committees and acts in place of the President in his absence. The Secretary keeps records of key points made during the meetings to be made available to club members, as well as writes letters for the organization. The Treasurer keeps the financial records of the organization, keeps the officer's roster up to date, and prepares the budget. Only members of the club are permitted to be an officer of the organization.

Section 4: In the case of vacancy in the office of the President, the Vice-President assumes their duties. In the case of vacancy in the office of the Secretary or Treasurer, the offices are usually combined. The organization should ensure that there are at least two officers at any given time.

- rticle V. The organization should meet at least twice a month during the school year. Other meetings may be called as needed by the President.
- ticle VI. The quorum for the organization is eight members.

- cicle VII. Any questions of parliamentary procedure shall be decided by the organization and/or forms laid down in "Roberts Rules of Order", latest edition.
- cle VIII. The President and Advisor are allowed to withdraw funds held in the Brookdale student fund for this organization.
- college. Their duties are to be available to discuss with members of the organization, any problems or ideas that come up, as well as to provide some continuity for the club, year to year. Advisor(s) may participate in all activities of the group.
- rticle X. This organization shall abide by all applicable rules and regulations of the College and under the privileges as granted by the Student Services Board.
- rticle XI. This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the membership, provided the amendment was submitted in writing at a previous regular meeting, and notice of the proposed amendment was given to all members at least one week before the meeting on the constitutional amendment. Before becoming effective all amendments must be approved by the Student Life Board and Director of Student Life and Activities following procedure for recognition.
