 GPA of 2.5 is required for the Criminal Justice major.
 The Criminal Justice Baccalaureate degree requires a minimum of 120 credits for graduation. All students must complete one-half the major at Rutgers, a minimum of 18 credits.
 *Students who did not complete two years of a foreign language in high school are required to complete both terms of a first year, college-level foreign language
 IMPORTANT: Students who do not offer 3 units of secondary school work in college preparatory mathematics including Algebra II or higher, must complete MATH151 at Brookdale Community College. **NOTE: Math courses must meet on campus, in classroom for at least five weeks to be granted transfer credit from the New Brunswick Math department.
 The Degree Plan is a recommended plan of study, additional courses are transferable as outlined on NJ Transfer and per the Statewide Transfer Agreement.
 In order to receive transfer credit all courses must have a BCC course number and grade recorded on the BCC transcript. Tech Prep credits and other professional credits (such as Police Academy articulated credits) that are accepted as transfer credits by BCC do not, in turn, transfer to Rutgers University.
