

**Rutgers-Newark – Brookdale Psychology Articulation
AA Social Science, Psychology Option – BA Psychology**

1. Requires GPA of 2.8 or higher; 3.0 recommended
2. Courses with a grade of C will transfer
3. Allows for transfer of up to 60 credits (program total is 120)
4. Requires completion of the Brookdale AA Social Science, Psychology Option or Psychology concentration (graduates of other programs will have transcripts evaluated course-by-course)
5. Students with an AA degree in another discipline will be considered for admission; completion of PSYC 105 and PSYC 106 prior to application is highly recommended

General Education Courses students are recommended to take:

PSYC 106 Intro to Psychology II (SS) (highly recommended)
PSYC 206 Human Growth & Development I (SS)

Required Career Courses:

PSYC 105 Intro to Psychology
PSYC 208 Life Span Human Development
*PSYC 247 Quantitative Methods in Psychology (4)

Career Studies Courses (recommended to best utilize 60 credits):

PSYC 217 Social Psychology
- Other Psychology courses transfer as posted on NJ Transfer

Recommended Elective course:

PSYC 216 Abnormal Psychology or PSYC 219 Positive Psychology

*PSYC 245 & 246 combined also meet this requirement

Rutgers-Newark requires major course requirements to be completed within the last ten years.
