TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BLOOMFIELD COLLEGE and BROOKDALE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This agreement between Brookdale Community College (BCC) and Bloomfield College (BC) connects students in the BCC Associate of Applied Science Degree in Music Technology to the BC Bachelor of Arts in Creative Arts & Technology with a concentration in Music Technology. These connected degree programs enable students to complete their associate degrees and then transfer seamlessly to Bloomfield College.

1. Subject to the following provisions, all students who complete the A.A.S. degree in Music Technology at Brookdale Community College will be granted admission to Bloomfield College upon proper application.
2. Students applying for the B.A. in Creative Arts and Technology/Music Technology Concentration must
 - a. have a grade point average of 2.30 or higher on the scale of 4.0;
 - b. submit an essay describing their creative work and aspirations (“What are your creative ambitions and what do you want to learn as a Creative Arts and Technology major?”);
 - c. Provide a portfolio and meet with the discipline coordinator for portfolio review.
3. Students may not receive credit for:
 - ◆ Courses with a grade below a C
 - ◆ Mathematics courses not equivalent to courses offered for General Education credit at Bloomfield College (MTH 130, MTH 140/141, MTH 160/161)
 - ◆ Credit earned by exam
 - ◆ Internship credit
 - ◆ Portfolio Learning Assessment credit
 - ◆ Other courses not offered for degree credit at Bloomfield College
4. Grades accepted in the major are subject to a minimum grade requirement for graduation. Students must achieve a grade point average of 2.0 or better in major required courses, with no more than two of these grades in the range of C – to D-.
5. Under this agreement class standing is predicated upon the number of credits accepted.
6. Students must fulfill the same requirements for the B.A. degree as specified in the Bloomfield College regulations at the time of their admission, including General Education, major requirements, and electives.

7. Students will receive at least 24 credits (6 course units) towards General Education *elective* requirements depending upon which courses are taken at Brookdale. Students transferring to BC for the B.A. in Creative Arts & Technology/Music Technology will be required to meet the following General Education Elective requirements:
 - ◆ Aesthetic Appreciation – 2 course units
 - ◆ Communication Skills – 1 course unit
 - ◆ Scientific and Technological Skills – 1 course unit
 - AND
 - ◆ Multi/Transcultural and Global Awareness – 2 course units
 - ◆ Problem Solving and Critical Thinking – 2 course units
 - or
 - ◆ Multi/Transcultural and Global Awareness – 1 course unit *and*
 - ◆ Problem Solving and Critical Thinking – 2 course units *and*
 - ◆ Citizenship and Community Orientation – 1 course unit

8. Credit toward the major course requirements for the B.A. in Creative Arts and Technology / Music Technology Concentration at Bloomfield College will be awarded as a package. Students who have completed the A.A.S. in Music Technology at Brookdale County College will have the following 9.5 course units (38 credits) remaining in the major to take at Bloomfield College:
 - ◆ CAT 257 / Video I (1.0 cu/4 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 300 / Composition & MIDI Programming I (1.0 cu/4 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 301 / Composition & MIDI Programming II (1.0 cu/4 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 310 / Digital Audio Engineering II (Mixing) (1.0 cu/4 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 323 / Music Industry Essentials (1.0 cu/4 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 380 / Internship I (1.0 cu/4 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 401 / (Advanced Synthesizer Programming & Electronic Music (Pre-Capstone Music Technology (1.0 cu / 4 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 402 / Developing a Record Project (0.5 cu/2 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 410 / Digital Audio Engineering: Practicum (1.0 cu/4 credits)
 - ◆ CAT 420 / Capstone (1.0 cu/4 credits)

9. Students must complete a minimum of 8 course units/32 credits at Bloomfield College to meet the Bloomfield College residency requirements.

10. Any modifications to the curriculum or course equivalencies are subject to approval of the chief academic officers of both Brookdale Community College and Bloomfield College.

11. Each institution will inform the other in a timely manner of proposed and affected modifications of programs covered in this agreement.

12. This Agreement will remain in effect from September 1, 2016 through August 30, 2021, or until modification by mutual consent or termination with one-year written notice by either party.
