

**Articulation Agreement
between
Goddard College
and
Brookdale Community College**

Purpose

The objective of this agreement is to promote the transfer of graduates of the Brookdale Community College Humanities Program Associate of Arts Degree - Creative Writing Option to the Goddard College Low-Residency Bachelor of Fine Arts in Creative Writing Program.

Admissions Requirements:

1. Goddard College will accept into its B.F.A. in Creative Writing Program, Brookdale Community College Humanities Program-A.A. Degree-Creative Writing Option graduates who have completed 60 transferable credits, based on the transfer credit policy of Goddard College (see Appendix A).
2. Brookdale Community College graduates will submit the following application materials to the Goddard College Admissions Office for review:
 - A completed application form
 - Official Brookdale Community College transcripts (also official transcripts from previously attended schools, if applicable)
 - Application Essays as outlined on the application form

These materials are necessary for successful matriculation into Goddard College undergraduate programs; specifically, for assigning faculty advisors and academic advising on the part of Goddard College faculty and staff.

In addition, all students transferring to Goddard College from Brookdale Community College under the terms of this agreement will schedule and complete a personal interview with a member of the Goddard College Admissions staff. This can be a phone interview or attendance at Discover Goddard Day. Its primary purpose is to assure that Goddard College is a good academic fit for the prospective student from Brookdale Community College.

Curriculum and Graduation Requirements

1. Brookdale Community College graduates who enroll at Goddard College with between 60 and 74 credits accepted in transfer will matriculate as first-semester, third-year undergraduate students.

2. Brookdale Community College students admitted to Goddard College undergraduate programs will be required, as are all Goddard College graduates, to fulfill all Bachelor of Fine Arts degree requirements, a College Undergraduate Progress Review and Senior Study before the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree will be conferred.
3. To be eligible for admission to Goddard College under the terms of this agreement, Brookdale Community College graduates who enroll at Goddard College will be guaranteed the transfer of credit for courses whose grades are C or better. (Courses with grades C- or lower do not transfer.) If the transfer is more than two years after the completion of the Brookdale Community College Associate Degree, Goddard College reserves the right to review the courses and their academic content.
4. Brookdale Community College A.A. Degree students will be held to the policies that are in effect at the time they are admitted to Goddard College.
5. The Goddard College Undergraduate Student Handbook, Undergraduate Curriculum Guide, along with the B.F.A. Handbook Addendum, provide further information regarding degree requirements. Students considering transfer to Goddard College are encouraged to communicate this intention as early as possible to a Brookdale Community College advisor and the Goddard College B.F.A. in Creative Writing Program Director.
6. Review of this agreement shall take place between Goddard College and Brookdale Community College every three years starting in September 1, 2012. Goddard College and Brookdale Community College will inform one another of changes in course or degree requirements in conjunction with the triennial review and revise the articulation agreements as needed during this period.
