- 1. Courses must be completed with a grade of C or higher.
- 2. Students planning to declare a major in Accounting at Rutgers must have completed ACCT 101 and ACCT 102 with a minimum grade of B.
- 3. MATH 171 college level course prerequisites (MATH 153, MATH 152, MATH 151)
- 4. RBS-NB accepts transfer students for the fall semester only (no mid-year transfers).
- 5. To be admitted to RBS-NB as a business major in the fall as a junior, all Eligibility Courses must be completed by the end of the previous spring term.
- 6. To be admitted to RBS-NB as a pre-business major in the fall, Pre-Calculus (MATH152&MATH153) must be completed by the end of the spring term as well as at least two of the entrance requirements listed above. ACCT101&ACCT102 as well as COMP129&COMP128 count as one entrance requirement each.
- 7. To qualify for the Statewide Transfer Agreement (Lampitt Bill), Rutgers requires students transferring with an A.A. degree to have a specific course dedicated to the Diversity category; Cultural and Global Awareness (CG). The CG course may not have been used to fill a Humanities, History or Social Science requirement and the course must be completed as part of the student's A.A. degree. In order for this course to be recognized by Rutgers, it must be completed prior to graduation with the A.A. degree. Students graduating with an A.S. Business Administration do not have this requirement.
- 8. Once a student graduates with an Associate's Degree from a community college, RBS does not accept any additional classes or credits taken at that school or any other community college.
