



Brookdale Community College and Saint Joseph's College

Transfer Agreement

This Agreement provides transfer admission opportunities for academically qualified students and graduates of the Brookdale Community College Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Radiologic Technology, who are interested in completing their Bachelor of Science in Radiologic Science Administration (BSRSA) degree through Saint Joseph's College Online (SJC).

Terms of Agreement:

- I. The Saint Joseph's College online program most suitable for articulation with the Brookdale Community College Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Radiologic Technology program is the following: Bachelor of Science in Radiologic Science Administration degree program with a progressive path to a Master of Health Administration The accompanying degree plan table reflects the degree requirements for the BSRSA program, which may be subject to change.
- II. Saint Joseph's College will accept for admission a degree candidate who has earned a grade point average of 2.0 or better (based on a 4.0 scale) into the online Bachelor of Science in Radiologic Science Administration degree program, upon confirmation of official transcripts. The student must be in good standing with the Brookdale Community College Radiologic Technology program and meet any specific admission and enrollment standards and requirements for the program at Saint Joseph's College.
- III. The Brookdale Community College Radiologic Technology program students accepted at Saint Joseph's College will receive academic credit for all College level courses that were successfully completed with a letter grade of C or better and are deemed

comparable (based on current course description information, course/degree requirements and agreement by the representatives of the respective programs) to current SJC courses. Non-credit or remedial courses will not be accepted for transfer credit and/or graduation requirements. All transcripts will be reviewed on an individual basis.

- IV. Brookdale Community College Radiologic Technology students/graduates need to submit an application and official transcripts from Brookdale Community College, as well as any other educational institutions previously attended.
- V. If a student does not have the foundation or skill to enroll in an upper level course due to a lack of the appropriate introductory course(s), any necessary prerequisite course(s) will be required.
- VI. Prerequisite and/or general education courses required for the Associate of Applied Science in Radiologic Technology degree may be transferred from Brookdale Community College or other accredited institutions, but 25% of the identified course requirements must be completed at Saint Joseph's College.
- VII. Saint Joseph's College agrees to waive the application fee for all students of the Brookdale Community College Radiologic Technology program.
- VIII. This agreement will be reviewed annually and may be revised by mutual consent. In addition, Saint Joseph's College and Brookdale Community College agree to notify one another in writing, at least one semester in advance of program changes that might affect the transfer of students under this agreement.
- IX. Both entities agree to the right to use each other's names in print and media advertising to the public for the purpose of marketing the programs described herein.
- X. Brookdale Community College agrees to promote this partnership and provide informational materials to their students and graduates. Saint Joseph's College will reciprocate by including the partnership on their transfer webpage.
