**Honors Program Articulation:**

The intent of this Honors Program Articulation Agreement is to provide an opportunity for graduates of the **Brookdale Community College** Honors Program to transfer seamlessly to the University Honors Program of **Georgian Court University**.

**Honors Course Transfer:**

Brookdale Community College students who complete the 18-credit Brookdale Community College Honors Program and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 will have fulfilled the Freshman and Sophomore Year requirements of the Georgian Court University Honors Program. Brookdale general education courses will fulfill the Georgian Court University general education requirements as defined on the NJ Transfer system.

**To Enter the Honors Program at GCU:**

Students who complete the 18-credit Brookdale Community College Honors Program and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 should send the Director of the GCU Honors Program a letter (which can be an email message) requesting admission, and a current official transcript that shows completion of the honors courses and honors program with the required minimum cumulative GPA.

**To Graduate from GCU with University Honors:**

Students who are admitted to the GCU Honors Program according to the parameters above will then be required to complete EN221 (grade of C or better), Honors GEN400, an honors version of the general education capstone course, and two other honors classes. These last two may be traditional honors courses, or may be fulfilled via honors by contract. They will be expected to satisfy all other requirements of the GCU University Honors Program, including but not limited to, maintaining a 3.3 cumulative GPA and maintaining a GPA of 3.0 in their honors courses.

**To Graduate from GCU with Degree Honors:**

To be eligible for degree honors (cum laude, magna cum laude, summa cum laude), students must earn at least 60 Georgian Court University credits. "Degree Honors" are distinct from "University Honors" (see GCU catalog).
