\*Graduates with an Associate's degree from a U.S. college (other than Berkeley College) may be eligible for Berkeley's Transfer Opportunity Program Grant. Awardee must be rolled full-time in a Bachelor's degree program at Berkeley. Awards are applied after all federal grants, Post-9/11 GI bill amounts, state grants, and state scholarships have been applied, not to exceed the remaining tuition amount. Cannot combine with any other Berkeley College grants or scholarships. Cost of books, supplies and fees not included. The grant is renewable if you maintain a cumulative Berkeley College GPA of 2.0 or higher and Satisfactory Academic Progress at the end of each award year. (NOTE: GPA requirements may be higher for certain programs.)
